The Needs Assessment/Service Coordination includes needs interview, service plan, and service coordination to meet your goals.

Our Service Coordinator is an Accredited Equipment Assessor who can check whether you can qualify for equipment from government funding.

We organize a range of educational workshops presented in New Zealand Sign Language, open to all Deaf people.
