Epilepsy Northland supports anyone affected by epilepsy. We have the latest information about epilepsy and our Field Officer can provide personal support, information and advocacy.



Services Provided

Educational programmes for people with epilepsy, including their family/whanau and friends. This is designed to increase understanding of epilepsy, the medications and services available.

Educational services for professionals who work with people with epilepsy such as ambulance service staff, police, nurses and teachers.

Community awareness through speaking engagements in service clubs, workplaces, schools and recreational clubs.

We also assist work places by educating the workmates and staff to be able to be a better support to the person with epilepsy, including seizure management planning that provides strategies to help the person with epilepsy gain control of their seizures and build confidence.

We are working on building up social interest groups in order that those who have epilepsy can interact with others in a supportive environment, knowing that their peers will fully understand and know what to do if they have a seizure whilst out.
